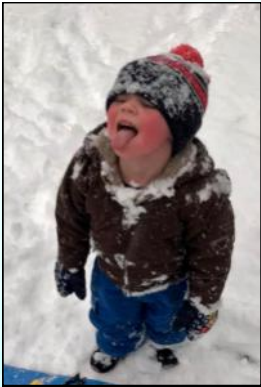

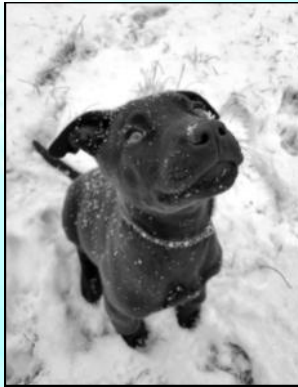

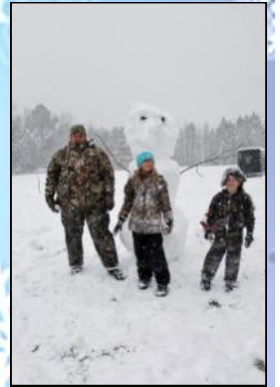

Delegate Christopher K. Peace took time out from his busy schedule to speak at a Town Hall meeting December 12, at Rehoboth Baptist Fellowship Church in King William.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss prescription drug and Opioid misuse in King William and surrounding areas. Delegate Peace stated "The 2018 General Assembly expanded Medicaid eligibility to individuals with income up to 138% of the federal poverty level which will make Medicaid addiction recovery and treatment services available if needed. Panelists Jeff Walton, Sheriff of King William county said, "This problem is all over the place and it effects everyone. I have been doing this 30 plus years now, we have to stay on top of this."

Matthew Kite, King William County Commonwealth Attorney spoke at the town hall meeting stating, "If you come before our court we are going to look for a solution for the first time offenders."

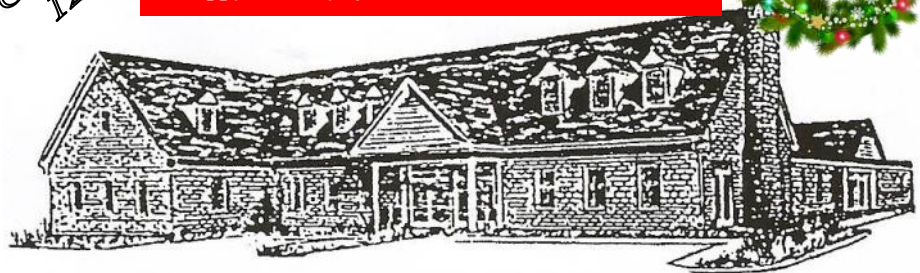

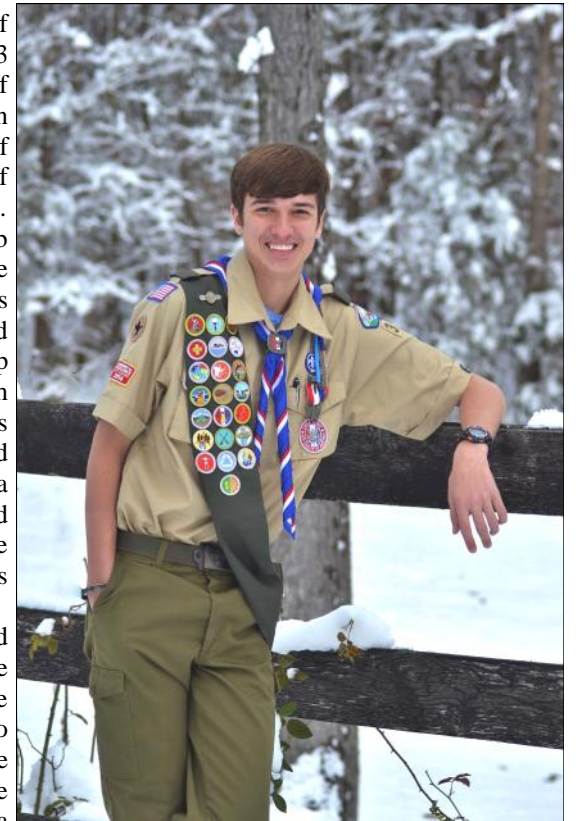

families to experience the thrill of deer hunting. At lunch time everyone gathered at Prestley Park (many thanks to Tommy Adkins of Dragon Run Brewery for providing this venue for lunch) for a delicious meal cooked by the "Bush Boys" (William and Stuart Bush) along with members of the King William Ruritan Club and others including Chris Simmons of "Soggy

Bottom Catering" and Phil Wyatt.
