The Purina manufacturing facility began operations in King William County in 1997. Over the years the factory has increased production. In 2015 a large expansion doubled the total litter manufacturing capacity that produces Tidy Cats litter products.

The company proudly employs nearly 300 people from local areas. This company is very supportive of King William citizens and pets. During the COVID – 19 crisis through an initiative called Operation Stand Up, Purina bought daily meals for all employees from local restaurants for ten weeks. The local restaurants used were: Another Round or 2, Chillin & Grillen, Halterman's Eatery, Lark Baking, Ripley's Family Restaurant, Roma Ristorante, Skrimp Shack, Subway, Vinny's Italian, and Zaxby's. This act of local community support brought thousands of dollars to local restaurants.

Recent donations to the county have aided construction of a new dog park. According to Jenner Leleux, Recreation Manager, "We are extremely fortunate to have such an amazing community partner with Purina. They are offering their staff a community day to come help install the equipment in the park.

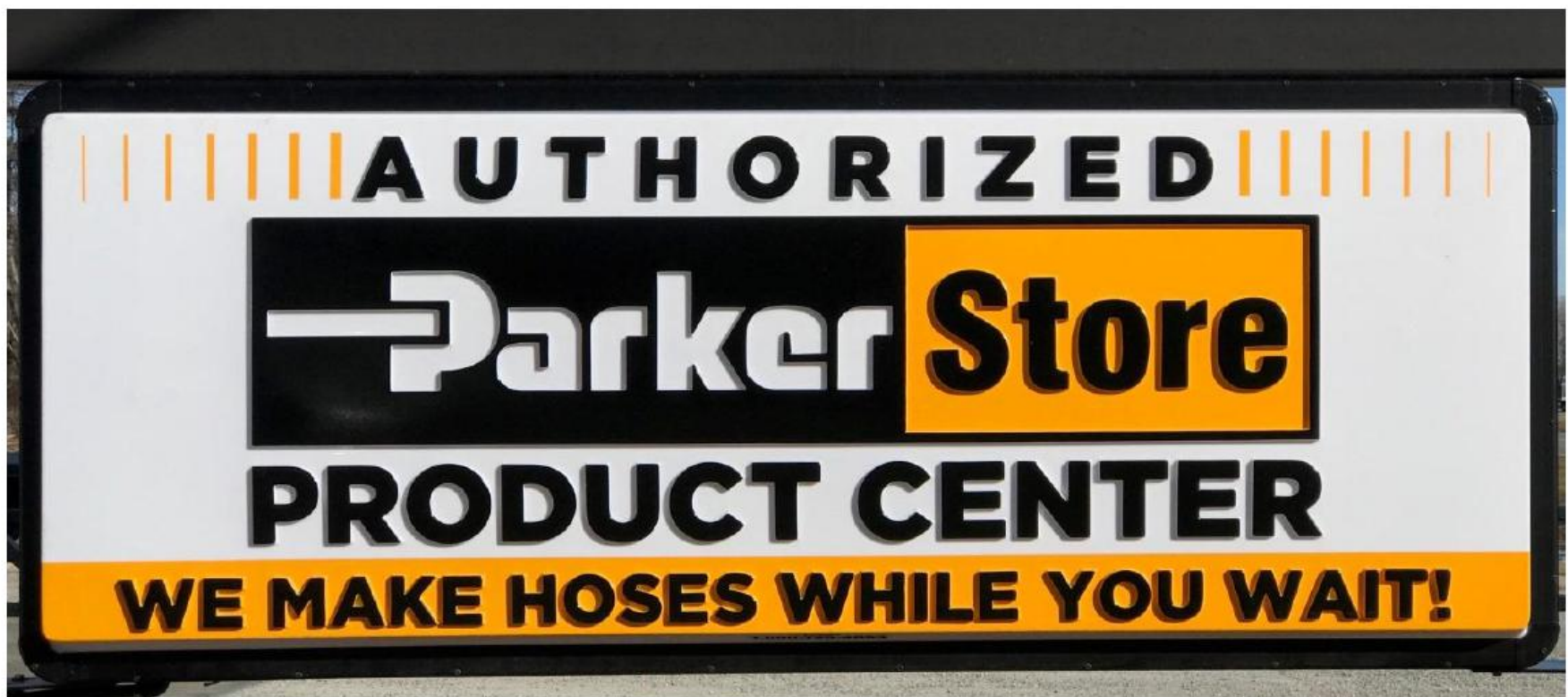

## Equine Talk Sponsored by: T-Town Tack

### Trailer Time

Trailers are an important part of horse people's lives. With show seasons and trail riding, we need to make sure our trailers are in good shape and everything is working properly and safely. Trailers come in lots of sizes from straight load, slant load, or stock trailers and can be either bumper pull or goose-neck. We know to always check the tires for wear and proper inflation and to check to make sure that all the lights are working. We also need to check the brakes and wheel bearings so as not to have any problems with pulling or stopping. The flooring needs to be looked at for any weak spots that the horse may crack or step through. Check the inside of the trailer to make sure there are no sharp or loose objects that could injure your animal. Our trailers sit sometimes for long periods without use so we need to keep a good eye on their condition. I remember a story about a friend of mine that had the bright idea of him getting inside the horse trailer and have his wife take him for a short trip to make sure everything was safe and tight. She closed him in the back and locked the rear doors and got in the truck and drove around for 10 or 15 minutes



before pulling back in at their house. She said she heard beating and yelling coming from the back of the trailer so she jumped out and opened the rear doors on the trailer. Her husband ran by her with his hands in the air screaming and using some bad language. It took a little bit for her to catch up him and calm him down. She said it looked like someone had beaten him with a stick. He had knots and whelps all over his head and arms. Come to find out, wasps had built a nest inside the trailer and he had gotten stung several times once they started down the road. I'm sure that he will always check the inside of the trailer for unwanted bees and wasps from now on.

## ACDS Targets New Trapshooting Team

While team sports throughout the nation were halted during the spring of 2020, Aylett's newly formed Trap Team was able to continue their socially-distanced weekly practices and competition. In February 2020, Aylett Country Day School joined the USA High School Clay Target League, as students in grades 6-12 are eligible to participate in the League. Ten Aylett students in grades 6-8 formed the inaugural team and enjoyed learning the sport, achieving personal goals, and safely practicing their marksmanship. Although other Virginia schools had planned on participating in the League's spring season, school closures due to COVID-19 forced them to cancel. ACDS was the only school in Virginia to complete the 2020 season.

The ACDS Trap Team was formed out of the students' interest in marksmanship, hunting, and firearms, however, the team needed a leader and facility to practice. A parent

suggested asking Mr. Robert Hayden to consider the role. Mr. Hayden, an accomplished trap shooter in the 1980-90's eagerly agreed to teach and guide the new team. Mr. Hayden has been a member of the Amateur Trap Association since 1989 and has competed in trap competitions throughout the United States. He has won numerous trophies, shotguns, and cash prizes, including the Virginia State Zone Handicap Championship and the Virginia State Doubles Championship. With the help of three friends and fellow Dunbrooke Hunt Club members, Mr. Hayden initiated the building of an ATA-certified trap field at Dunbrooke Hunt Club in the mid-90s. The members of Dunbrooke Hunt Club granted permission for the Aylett Trap Team to use their facility this spring for team practices with Mr. Hayden's leadership.

Aylett's trap team met every Sunday afternoon at DHC from February 16-May 27 for an hour to practice their shooting skills. Along with Coach Hayden, Mr. J.D. Stamper, Range Safety Officer, and Mr. David Campbell, assistant coach, volunteered their time and expertise with the team each week. A practice consisted of shooting two 25 target rounds for a total of 50 targets from the 16-yard station. Up to five athletes occupied the stations on the





trap field. Scores were recorded and submitted to the League. At the beginning of the season, Aylett team members averaged hitting 54% of the clay targets. At the end of the season, the average increased to 74%. In late May, Coach Hayden presented the Trap Team Coach's Award to 8th grader, Kemp Davis, for consistently demonstrating leadership, encouragement of teammates, and strong commitment to the sport. The MVP Award was presented to Jackson Garner, 7th grade student, as his average was 86%. Jackson also shot "25 straight" during one team practice. Every team member greatly improved their skill set and marksmanship throughout the season. ACDS

will be the featured school in an upcoming edition of PULL Magazine.

Coach Hayden shared, "I was fortunate to be given the opportunity to work with Aylett's students this year, and I would not have traded it for anything. I thoroughly enjoyed teaching and getting to know the boys. I witnessed a lot of talent and am happy to see another generation interested in trapshooting."

ACDS plans to continue their trap team momentum in Fall 2020 and is hopeful more public and independent schools (boys and girls) will join the USA Clay Target League. For more information on Aylett Country School, please visit [acdspatriots.net](http://acdspatriots.net).

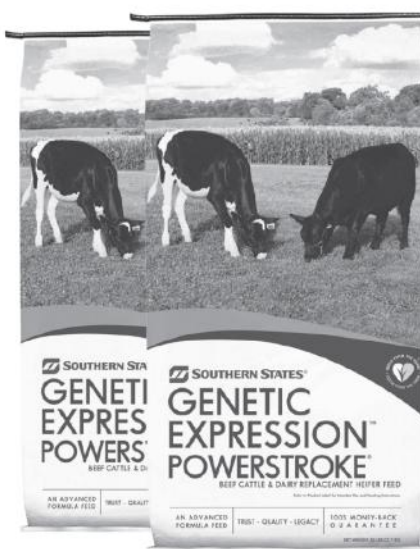

## Bay Aging's insurance counseling services provide free, unbiased guidance



While the annual Medicare enrollment period does not begin until October 15<sup>th</sup>, Lisa Walker, Bay Aging's Vice President of Advocacy Resources, says this is a great time to speak with one of Bay Aging's Virginia Insurance Counseling & Assistance Program (VICAP) counselors. "Now is a really great time to call," Ms. Walker said. "Call volumes are not as heavy as they are during a typical Medicare enrollment period and there is always lots of information to share with Medicare beneficiaries or their caregivers. Social Security's 'Extra Help' program can save people up to \$5,000 a year on Medicare prescription drug plan costs. There are also expanded telehealth options available to Medicare recipients that many consumers may not be familiar with."

COVID-19 has limited the number of in-person presentations to area churches, civic organizations, libraries and other community groups, that Ms. Walker typically does. Yet, Walker noted that "most of our counseling work is done over the phone and rarely requires an in-person meeting. These days we are available to reach out to these groups via Zoom webinars and hold group presentations, but I'm hoping to raise awareness of VICAP through the media so people will

call our toll-free number and take advantage of this incredible, free service."

Bay Aging's VICAP program is part of a national network of programs that offers, free, unbiased, confidential counseling and assistance for to help people navigate the complexities of Medicare enrollment. VICAP coordinators and volunteers provide education, counseling and assistance to older consumers and people with disability insurance on topics such as medical benefits programs, long-term care insurance, Medicare and Medicaid.

## King & Queen Schools Accredited

The state Board of Education recognized on June 18, 2020 a total of 447 schools and six school divisions for high student achievement, continuous improvement or innovative practices under the board's exemplar school recognition program. The awards are based on performance and practice during 2018-2019 and prior years.

The recognized schools include 71 schools that earned the Board of Education Highest Achievement Award, 375 schools that earned the Board of Education Continuous Improvement Award and one school that earned the Board of Education Innovative Practice Award. "The criteria for the exemplar performance awards are designed to incentivize schools to make the changes in instruction, policy, support services and practice required to make progress toward meeting the Board of Education's objective of achieving equity in opportunities and outcomes for all student," Board of Education President Daniel A. Gecker said. "The increase in the number of awards earned this year is evidence of the progress our schools were making toward this objective before the pandemic forced the closure of schools in March."

James Lane, Superintendent of Public Instruction said, "I believe the success of these schools are school divisions will inspire learning communities across the commonwealth as they plan for the reopening of school and prepare to meet the instructional and social-emotional needs of students - especially students most impacted by the closure this spring."

"Lawson Marriott Elementary School was one of 71 schools in the State of Virginia that received the 2020 Board of Education Highest Achievement Award. Schools recognized for highest achievement were "Accredited" during

the 2019-2020 (based on performance data from 2018-2019) and demonstrated high levels of success across all of school quality indicators, including success in narrowing achievement gaps.

Schools also had to meet the Level One accreditation benchmark for reading, mathematics, and science based on the student pass rate, not including growth or progress on assessments taken by English language learners. Schools must also have had no more than a 5% achievement gap, for schools with two student groups, or a 10% gap, for schools with three or more student groups, between the lowest-performing group and all other students in the school. In addition, schools must have achieved at Level One on all other applicable school quality indicators."

"Central High School was one of 375 schools earning the 2020 Board of Education Continuous Improvement Award. These schools were recognized for continuous improvement and rated "Accredited" or "Accredited with Conditions" for 2019-2020 and met at least one of the following four criteria based on performance during 2018-2019: A 10 point increase in the combined rate in reading and math, and in the pass rate in science; a 10 point increase in the combined rate in reading and math for two or more student groups across three years, a decrease in the chronic absenteeism rate for three years or for schools with a graduating class, an increase in the Graduation and Completion Index and a decrease in the dropout rate for three years".

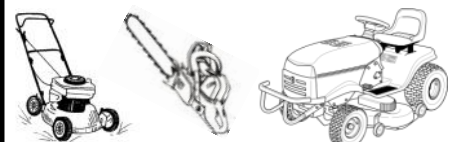
