



King and Queen County Public Schools Reopening Plan for 2020-2021

Board approved a Reopening Plan for the 2020 -2021 school year on July 15, 2020. King and begin the 2020-2021 school year on Tuesday, September 8, 2020. This later start date participate in professional development. provides additional time for the staff to prepare for instruction through a hybrid in person and buildings are outfitted with the necessary items environment.

Students in grades PK-7 will follow an AA/ BB schedule. Students in Group A will receive physical distancing on routes with fewer instruction on-site Monday and Tuesday and work remotely from home Wednesday through Friday. Students in Group B will work remotely from home Monday through have internet access or the means to access Wednesday and receive instruction on-site through other options such as driving to an area Thursday and Friday. Wednesdays will be utilized for cleaning procedures, teacher planning and professional development.

Students in grades 8-12 will follow an A/B/C grades 10 and 12 will attend on B days and mailed to all families."

"King and Queen County Public School Grades 9 and 11 will attend on C days. Student schedules will be based on a 7-period day for the 2020-2021 school year. Teachers will Queen Public Schools (KQPS) schools will utilize non-instructional time to provide remediation, plan for remote learning and

Any siblings throughout the division will be on-site the same days, regardless of which remote learning model. It also ensures schools they attend. Students will be required to wear masks on the bus and in the building to support a safe and healthy learning when 6' distancing cannot be maintained. The division will request a variance to have students sit one per seat and will maintain students.

KING AND QUEEN COUNTY, VIRGINIA Courthouse Security Ordinance Amendment

Pursuant to Section 53.1-120 of the Code of Virginia, the Board of Supervisors of King and Queen County will hold a public hearing to consider amending Section 2-142 of the County Code. This proposed amendment will increase court costs from \$10.00 to \$20.00 per court case, which will be used for the funding of courthouse security personnel. 
