Local football announcer Ed Gray died suddenly on Sunday, December 20, 2020. For 25 years Friday night home football games at King William High School were announced by the strong informative voice of Ed Gray. At the request of Athletic Director Bob Murray, Ed started announcing the games in 1993 and retired in 2018. He also announced some cheerleading competitions, basketball playoff games, and some parades. This was something he really enjoyed doing.

Ed grew up in Richmond and was a cadet at John Marshall High School from which he graduated. While he was in the Air Force, he got training in medical supplies while working at a hospital in Spain. When he became a civilian, he became a medical supply salesman.

During the week of June 15th-18th, the Virginia State FFA held its annual convention virtually. The King William High School FFA won numerous chapter awards and individual awards, and even had a state winner.

On November 23rd the State FFA presented to the FFA chapters across the state. King William FFA chapter won State Awards for Forestry Field Day and also won area awards for Superior Chapter, Chapter Forestry, and Wildlife. Individually, the chapter had four students receive the highest state award a member can receive; this was called a State FFA degree. Members who were rewarded their State degrees were Leah Pennington, Mattie Watkins, Will Reed, and Tanner Lipscomb. Tanner Lipscomb also received a runner up award for his Ag. Processing Proficiency project. Tanner was selected by the State FFA as the State Star in Agribusiness. He competed in Nationals using a virtual format. In his interview the judges commended him on the knowledge of his project which was crabbing in the tidal areas of Virginia. Tanner was also chosen as the National Star in Agribusiness.
