Where is Walker? The answer is that he's back at home with his family after being missing for 526 days. Walker is a young male beagle that went missing October 4th, 2020 in Newtown. His picture has been shared thousands of times on Facebook and there's even a page dedicated to finding him. Once he was found his family stated, "To all of you out there with missing fur babies: NEVER GIVE UP!!! MIRACLES DO HAPPEN!"

Here's Walker's version of his story:

I was taken by a man on Byrd's Mill Road that day that I went missing.

Maggie and I had gone running after a rabbit and we ended up getting lost. Then, Maggie and I got in an argument about which direction would lead home and we ended up going separately trying to beat the other home. 






Tribute to our Mother who passed away 34 years ago at the age of 45







This ordinance is no longer necessary.
