## Covid-19 Vaccination Update



The CornerStone Free Health Clinic is a CDC organization that administers COVID-19 vaccines. Working together with Three Rivers and VDH the clinic has held six vaccine clinics since March 20, 2021. 298 people have received their first doses of Moderna. Second doses are currently being administered. For all those who would like to be vaccinated, first doses will be administered on April 30th from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. and May 15th from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. PLEASE email thecdc@gmail.com or call 804 769 2996 to request to be on the list for either of the two dates. Since the vaccine clinics are a drive through there are no appointment times.

You may have symptoms like a fever after you get a vaccine. This is normal and a sign that your immune system is learning how to recognize and fight the virus that causes COVID-19.

## 2021 King William GOP Republican Roundup

On Tuesday, April 20<sup>th</sup> the King William County Republican Committee hosted the 2021 Candidate Roundup at Fontainebleau Farm. WRVA radio personality John Reid emceed the event which featured 14 of 17 candidates seeking the Republican nomination in statewide races this year. RPV delegates will cast ballots on May 8th to nominate their picks for Lieutenant Governor, Governor, and Attorney General.

The event opened with King William resident Matt Sluder reading from Paul's letter in the book of Ephesians. Lindsay Robinson, another King William resident, read the Virginia Republican Creed. Virginia House of Delegates member Scott Wyatt spoke briefly to remind spectators all 100 seats in the House will be on the ballot in November. This could give the Republican party an opportunity to take control of the state House.

### Trailer Time

Trailers are an important part of horse people's lives. With show seasons and trail riding, we need to make sure our trailers are in good shape and everything is working properly and safely. Trailers come in lots of sizes from straight load, slant load, or stock trailers and can be either bumper pull or goose-neck. We know to always check the tires for wear and proper inflation and to check to make sure that all the lights are working. We also need to check the brakes and wheel bearings so as not to have any problems with pulling or stopping. The flooring needs to be looked at for any weak spots that the horse may crack or step through. Check the inside of the trailer to make sure there are no sharp or loose objects that could injure your animal. Our trailers sit sometimes for long periods without use so we need to keep a good eye on their condition.

I remember a story about a friend of mine that had the bright idea of him getting inside the horse trailer and have his wife take him for a short trip to make sure everything was safe and tight. She closed him in the back and locked the rear doors and got in the truck and drove around for 10 or 15



minutes before pulling back in at their house. She said she heard beating and yelling coming from the back of the trailer so she jumped out and opened the rear doors on the trailer. Her husband ran by her with his hands in the air screaming and using some bad language. It took a little bit for her to catch up him and calm him down. She said it looked like someone had beaten him with a stick. He had knots and whelps all over his head and arms. Come to find out, wasps had built a nest inside the trailer and he had gotten stung several times once they started down the road. I'm sure that he will always check the inside of the trailer for unwanted bees and wasps from now on.

It is budget time again for the King William County Board of Supervisors and guess what tool will be used again.

You guessed it – throw more "Money" at it. If anyone knows a time that this has worked, and the problem went away – Please write a letter to the editor with the particulars. We have all heard the cry of be a "Team Player" and stop complaining – you are the problem. The following is a walk down memory lane to refresh everyone's memory about how well throwing money at any problem will work. The following is from a "Letter to the Editor" I wrote in May of 2019.

In the May 15, 2019 issue of the *Country Courier* on page 12 Supervisor Dave Hansen's letter to the Editor gave a "Description" of which can only be described as a "Progressive's Dream" come true. We now have an unelected county administrator deciding the salaries of the county employees without the Board's review or approval as long as it is performed within budgetary constraints. Who decides what the constraints are?

The Voluntary Fire and EMS units in King William have been having financial trouble since before the 2015 election. I am sure most of you will remember the County Administer Trent Funkhouser, at that time having a meeting in each of our voting districts to get citizen input and

suggestions on how to proceed. To my knowledge no citizen suggestion was implemented. The manager of the Voluntary Fire and EMS's Salary was in the range of the about \$55,000.00.

The solution after Mr. Funkhouser left and a new County Administer assumed duty was to hire the current Chief of Fire & Emergency Services for \$71,936.00. I believe the citizens thought this would result in a handle finally being applied to the Voluntary Fire and EMS unit's financial troubles. What seems to have happened is the problem got bigger.

The local Mattaponi Volunteer Fire & Rescue figured out how to stay out of financial trouble. Mattaponi Volunteer Rescue Chief Curtis Mason Jr. offered to pay over \$500,000 to fund & help run King William Volunteer Fire & Rescue and the county would not have to pay a cent. He was told "No". The reward was the Mattaponi Unit will now not take calls for King William as reported in the Tidewater Review. You would think Curtis Mason would be the new King William Chief of Fire and Emergency Services with that kind of track record.

As stated in Supervisor Hansen's letter The Fire Chief's new top salary is \$100,710.00 and the County Administer gets to decide the wage.

We owe a Thank You to Supervisor Hansen. Can any citizen recall a Supervisor providing this type of information in a dollar and cents format with a clarity that all can understand in an election year. The next time you hear a candidate declare he or she is a team player – be sure to ask which team. (End of the May 2019 Letter)

Today in 2021 the county owns the King William Volunteer Fire & Rescue, grounds and buildings and are looking to hire 13 new personal in 2021. Does anyone miss Chief Curtis Mason Jr. and Supervisor Hansen Yet?

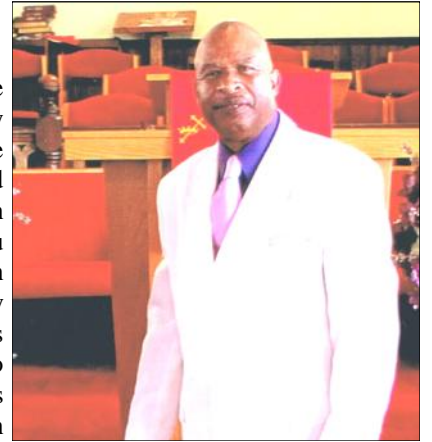

Hot topics included 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment rights, election integrity, abortion, school choice, the parole board, support for law enforcement, executive orders relating to Covid-19, and restrictions placed on Virginia based businesses. The candidates were made up of a diverse group of men and women from different ethnic, professional, and political backgrounds. Some of the candidates legally migrated from other countries to become U.S. citizens.

By preventing child abuse and neglect, our aim is to improve the lives of all families and the communities they live in. This is the reason we have come together to 'grow' a better tomorrow for all children, together by planting a pinwheel."

Kelly Magovero, the Family Service Specialist, stated "Our commitment is strengthening families and connecting our community to meet the needs of our most valuable citizens." She also read a proclamation from Governor Northam. Nina Williams, the Family Services Supervisor, shared many staggering statistics from the fiscal year 2019-20 concerning children in Virginia: 83,131 suspected cases of child abuse, 52,554 children involved as possible victims, and 33,880 completed reports. 33.2% of reports were concerning children three years old or younger, and 40.3% were ages 4-11. In King William, there were 202 referrals, and 32 were validated.

The Tri-City Chapter of B.A.C.A., Bikers Against Child Abuse, were partners in this



event. They stated that their mission is "to create a safer environment for abused children and to empower abused children to not feel afraid of the world in which they live."

If anyone has any concerns of child abuse or neglect, please call the Social Services office at 804-769-4905 to speak with a licensed social worker; there is always one on call, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

## Virginia Delegate Scott Wyatt sharpens focus on King William

Just before he was to speak at the latest meeting of the King William T.E.A. Party, 97th District Delegate Scott Wyatt heard a detailed presentation from local property owners who had successfully led the fight to have the county's recent, deeply flawed real estate assessments tossed out.

This hot button subject resurfaced in the question and answer session to Wyatt's scheduled remarks as citizens expressed their frustration at county government and the firm that did the assessment, "having no accountability when they violated Virginia law in numerous ways."

"We caught them again and again but none of the officials were held responsible," one business property owner said.

In response, Wyatt, a Republican who represents King William and nearby counties in the General Assembly, agreed to host a meeting with officials and citizens impacted by the many problems associated with this latest assessment.

"Bring in the Commissioner of Revenue, County Administrator, Board of Appeals and Equalization to see how they deal with these issues," he said.

Bob Shannon, KWTP's founder, emphasized the urgency of what is recognized as a statewide problem.

"Without the efforts of our group the

assessment would not have been overturned," he said. "The problems would have been swept under the rug and citizens would have had to live with the unequal, arbitrary and excessive results. It shows what can be done when citizens engage"

Shannon also urged Wyatt to submit legislation to amend the Virginia Statute, "putting in enforceable consequences for violations of the rules for property assessments."

The drill is a great size for reseeding your pasture or planting a wildlife food plot. The seeder has one large hopper and a small seed hopper. A deposit fee of \$100 will cover the first 10 acres. A charge of \$10 per acre will be charged after the first 10 acres. The amount charged is determined by the acreage meter on the drill. Call the District at (804)443-2327, ext. 4 to reserve your spot for spring planting. The equipment is rented on a

first come first served basis.

No-till planting is an economical and effective method of conservation tillage that offers many advantages over the more traditional tillage practices. Using no-till methods can increase seed germination and improve growth of forage compared to broadcasting. This conserves moisture in the seed bed and reduces the chance of soil erosion. The no-till method only requires one trip across the field, which lessens the potential for soil compaction and minimizes labor and fuel expenses.

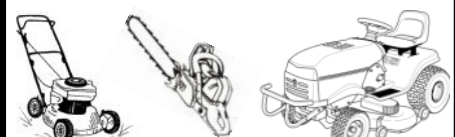

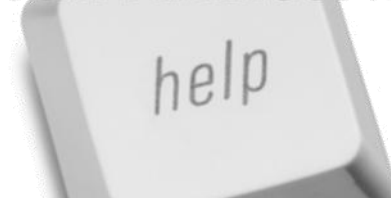

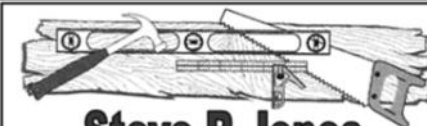
