The CornerStone Free Health Clinic is a CDC organization that administers COVID-19 vaccines. Working together with Three Rivers and VDH the clinic has held six vaccine clinics since March 20, 2021. 298 people have received their first doses of Moderna. Second doses are currently being administered. For all those who would like to vaccinated, first doses will be be administered on April 30th from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. and May 15th from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. PLEASE email theccdc@gmail.com or call 804 769 2996 to request to be on the list for either of the two dates. Since the vaccines clinics are a drive through there are no appointment times.

2021 King William GOP Republican Roundup

On Tuesday, April 20th the King William County Republican Committee hosted the 2021 Candidate Roundup at Fontainebleau Farm. WRVA radio personality John Reid emceed the event which featured 14 of 17 candidates seeking the Republican nomination in statewide races this year. RPV delegates will cast ballots on May 8th to nominate their picks for Lieutenant Governor, Governor, and Attorney General. The event opened with King William resident Matt Sluder reading from Paul's letter in the book of Ephesians. Lindsay Robinson, another King William resident, read the Virginia Republican Creed. Virginia House of Delegates member Scott Wyatt spoke briefly to remind spectators all 100 seats in the House will be on the ballot in November. This could give the Republican party an opportunity to take control of the state House.


