





## **Vans and Volunteers** The CornerStone Community Development

In April 2020, 'The CornerStone Community Development Center' was designated as one of the emergency food agencies in Virginia. This meant that food operations needed to be stepped up to cope with the sudden increase in the number of families and also due to the closure of several smaller food agencies. 


