King William Cavaliers Honored for State Win at the January BoS Meeting

By Amanda Walker- Community members packed the January King William Board of Supervisors January regular meeting to honor the King William Cavaliers Varsity Football Team for their 2021 VHSL Class 2 State Championship win against Graham High School. County Administrator Percy Ashcraft announced the entrance of the team, coaches, and cheerleaders while attendees gave a standing ovation. This is the first state football championship win for the Cavaliers since 2000. District 2 Supervisor Travis Moskalski was on the team at the time. Moskalski read and presented Resolution 22-08 to the Cavaliers, commemorating their hard work, determination, and exceptional teamwork both on and off the field. Virginia House Delegate Scott Wyatt has also introduced a similar resolution at the state level - House Resolution No. 8.
