Members of the Mattaponi and Pamunkey Rivers Association launched their kayaks at the Walkerton boat landing on June 20<sup>th</sup> for an evening paddle. The group paddled upriver just past North Point Plantation taking in the sights and enjoying conversation before paddling back down to the landing. MPRA President Audrey Mitchell shared anecdotes about Baldwin’s Store and Rose Clark’s time working there. She also reminisced about driving over the old Walkerton bridge prior to the one we traverse now opening up in the early 1990s.

MPRA is a local organization aimed at the conservation of the Mattaponi and Pamunkey rivers. The group organizes several paddles a year in addition to sponsoring fishing events, educational events, and river clean-ups. The next MPRA river paddle will be a Zoar to Aylett Boat Landing float on July 9<sup>th</sup> launching from Zoar on West River Road at 9 am. All are welcome to join. On July 15<sup>th</sup> MPRA is teaming up with 4-H and the Virginia Department of Forestry for a Kids Fishing Camp for ages 6-12 at Sandy Point State Forest from 9-12 pm. 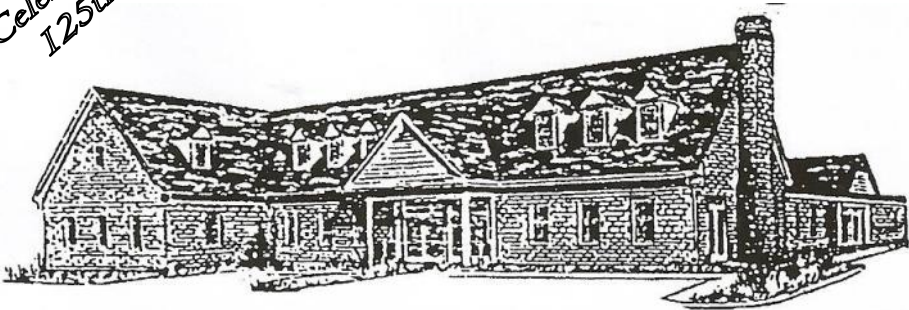

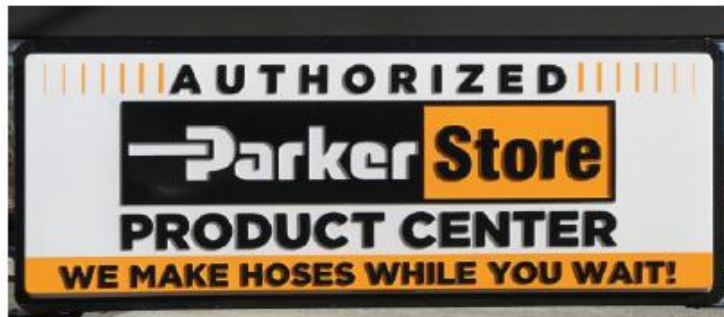

We all remember our school bus drivers during our school years. They were our 'second parent', someone who took us under their wing as we began the education journey in our lives. My favorite school bus driver was Gladys Mae Poynter. They don't come any better than Gladys Mae! Although I wasn't on her regular route, Gladys Mae took five classmates and me to Marriott High School every school morning one semester of my senior year to take a physics class needed for college admission. I recently sat down with Gladys Mae and one of her three daughters, Sandra Kersey (Valerie

Fitzgerald and Ginger Rice are the other two daughters) along with Sandra's husband John. Sandra was one of my fellow classmates in the 1968 graduating class at King William High School. We had a 'good ole time' reminiscing about the days of grade school and high school. Gladys Mae and Mrs. Adams were the first two female bus drivers in the King William County School System. Gladys Mae's bus was #35. She started driving in 1964 and drove for 34 years before retiring in 1998. "I loved every minute of it and would have driven the bus for free," she told me.

## King William BoS Funds Library Request

Following disapproval by citizens regarding the Upper King William and West Point Pamunkey Regional Library hours being cut by nearly 70% the King William Board of Supervisors backtracked on a decision to level fund the library for FY23. The library system has been level-funded for three years and requested a nearly 35% increase in funding for FY23. Library system Director Tom Shepley expressed to the board that not funding the request would result in a 50% reduction in operating hours. The board questioned Shepley on where other expenses may be cut but was met with no room for negotiation. Following the board's decision not to fund the increase citizens were informed both locations would be reduced to sixteen hours of operation per week, down from the 52 hours currently offered by the locations. The board voted 3-2 on Monday, June 27<sup>th</sup> to reverse the decision, pulling the funds from the county's unassigned fund. Board Chairman Ed Moren expressed that the decision they were faced with was funding sixteen hours at approximately \$445,000 or funding the full 52 hours at \$574,000. Supervisors Stephen Greenwood and Stuart Garber voted "nay" with Garber expressing that there was no willingness to negotiate by the library system.

Sherriff Jeff Walton also approached the

board to discuss bringing back road crews to help with litter cleanup. The program was previously eliminated due to budget cuts. The total cost of the program is \$141,173 and would be split between five localities if all agreed. Unfortunately, at least two of the localities have not expressed an interest in joining. The board voted unanimously to revisit the decision next year prior to budget approval. Walton is in favor of the program but agreed with the board that the decision should be revisited next year.

Several new appointments have been made to various community service boards. Walt Bailey and Brian Hodges will be replacing Doris White (resigned) and Benjamin Shumaker (expired term) on the Board of Zoning Appeals. Straughan Robinson III and Robert Hardwick be replacing Travis Longest (resigned) and Brian Hodges (expired term) on the Economic Development Authority. James D. Kellum will replace John Breeden (expired term) on the Planning Commission. Elizabeth Copeland was appointed to the Wetlands Board of Directors. All appointments were approved unanimously by the board with the exception of James D. Kellum being appointed to the Planning Commission. Supervisors Ed Moren and Travis Moskalski both voted "nay" on the decision.

Her first paycheck was less than \$100 a month. "I said good morning to every child as they got on the bus and said goodbye when they got off, and I would often give them fruit and candy." Gladys Mae believed in discipline too. "I had a list of rules posted on the inside of my bus as you entered," she said. Among her rules were no talking to students behind or in front of you and no getting up while the bus was moving. If you didn't abide by her rules, you would get an 'assigned seat' near the front of the bus usually behind her complete with your name on the seat. "That was where you sat for a month till you learned to behave and abide by the rules." One of her students asked for her assigned seat card at the end of her disciplinary period.... as a memento. "If I didn't discipline them that would mean I didn't give a diddly-squat" she exclaimed. "I was strict because I loved and cared about them!"

Gladys Mae is almost 91 years old but she sure doesn't look nor act 91. She has seen it all in her 34 years of school bus driving. She loves animals and many times would throw food to hungry stray dogs and cats she saw every day along her route. At several places on her route in the farming community, she had to stop and wait for cows to cross the road on their way to the milking parlor before she could continue. She remembers disciplining her future son-in-law Buddy Rice and his

brothers as they waited for the bus. "They would be scuffling and fighting as brothers do and I would tell them to behave," she said. On occasions in the wintertime, she would tell them to go back into the house and put on a jacket. If it was raining, she would drive her kids all the way to their homes instead of dropping them off at the stop. Sometimes she would wait for the parents of her last family of kids on her route to get home before leaving them. "We would talk about the day's activities while waiting on the parents."

We all had "Gladys Mae's" in our lives who shaped and molded us into what we are today. Gladys Mae proudly showed me a card she received last year from one of her school bus students. Jeniece Smith Roane said this about Gladys Mae. "You taught all of those who were fortunate enough to be students on your bus the importance of community, that the actions of one affected all, and you were unrelenting in your demand for respect and following the rules. At the time I was a student, and I had no appreciation of how those lessons were really lessons about life. They were lessons about responsibility. They were lessons about character. I reflect on those lessons often. I thank you for your influence and I am grateful to have been blessed to count you as a member of my village of life."

## The Fix Ministry

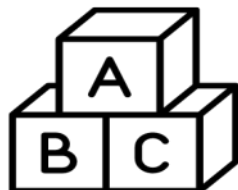
