## Local Motocross Racer Jacob Glenn

King William High School graduate, Jacob Glenn achieves his dream. He took the next step! When Jacob was a child, out family would go to the Pro National Races. He would hold on to the fence in amazement at how they did that and went so fast. Well, now he is on the other side of that fence with kids looking at him and asking the same thing. Jacob got his AMA Pro license in Motocross and Supercross. His AMA assigned number is 831. He has always ran the number 131 in memory of his grandmother. Jacob has been racing competitively since he was 9 years old. As a little boy watching dirt bike racing, he would say, "I'm going to be on TV one day just like those fast guys". Well, he did it! He raced his first professional race on July 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2022. This race was at RedBud MX track in Buchanan, Michigan. Which was televised for the whole world to see. There were 92 rider entries in the 450cc class and 89 entries in the 250cc class, which is the class Jacob raced in. Only 40 riders make it into the main event through timed qualifying. Jacob placed 49<sup>th</sup>, and only missed the main event by a few spots. However, this was great for his first time ever racing this track and it was the biggest Pro race of the season.

The Duncan House – Oldest Structure in King William

Close your eyes and let’s take a walk back in time. It’s 1781. You are in the town of Aylett on the Mattaponi River (as it was then known), an important river port and the largest center of trade and business for many miles around. As you start walking down West River Road (Rt 600) towards where Aylett Tire is now you see people coming out of well-stocked stores along the street. They are carrying fine fabrics, silks, jewelry, and trinkets of various kinds as well as the necessities of life. If you were about to get married this was the place to come to get a handsome wedding outfit with all the necessary accessories. To your left at the boat landing, you see ships being loaded with tobacco from nearby plantations while other ships are offloading consignments of goods from England. One might see a ship with a fine English-built coach to be drawn by four horses unloading on the pier en route to a local plantation, much like a new automobile being delivered by a dealership. To your immediate right, you see people mingling about and coming out of a tavern that serves meals much like a restaurant. You arrive just in time to see General George Washington coming out of the tavern with a toothpick in hand finishing off a fine meal on his way to visit his close friend Col. William Aylett at Fairfield Plantation some two miles to the east. George often traveled through Aylett from his Mount Vernon home on his way to Williamsburg.

Fast forward to today. Open your eyes and the only building you see, still there 241 years later, is the tavern. It sits across from The Berkeley House and St David’s Episcopal Church. The tavern is now called the Duncan House and is the home of Gladys Mae Poynter. No one knows for sure the date it was built but a historian from Williamsburg told Gladys Mae it was probably built in the late 1600s or early 1700s. The tavern was once the post office in Aylett. It is said to be one of the oldest structures, if not the oldest, in King William County. During the Civil War, the Yankees marched through Aylett burning everything in sight... except the tavern, the Berkeley House (partially burned), and St David’s Episcopal Church. After the Civil War, a Confederate officer with the last name Duncan moved into the tavern, therefore the name Duncan House. Gladys Mae and her husband William “Buck” Poynter moved into the house in 1951 after inheriting the house from Buck’s parents. The Poynter family has deep roots in the area and owned land at one time all the way to Marlboro approximately three miles east on Rt 600. Marlboro was once owned by the Poynter family and Buck’s father was born there.

The Duncan House has a fireplace in every room. Sandra Poynter Kersey, Gladys Mae’s daughter, told me a story about how a black snake once got into the house. Buck was tending to Sandra when she was a small child and suddenly a black snake fell down the chimney into the room. Buck quickly removed the snake from the house. After that day Buck had all the fireplaces bricked up. “Buck never liked a snake” exclaimed Gladys Mae!

## King William SOL Passing Scores See A Change

Since the mid 1990's, the Standards of Learning Tests or "SOL's" have been Virginia's primary tool for measuring student achievement and deciding graduation. They have also ensured that individual schools demonstrate consistently high standards by tying accreditation to passing scores. However, the Virginia SOL is undergoing transformation and the way those passing scores are determined has drastically changed.

During the June 21st School Board Meeting, the latest SOL pass rates for KWCPs were unveiled for the 2021-2022 school year. Despite the County Administrator's Blog offering congratulations to the district for their "leap" in scores and "significant progress," the Director of Curriculum and Instruction Dr. Stephanie Bassett explained that this year's SOL scores were not determined in the usual manner.

Bassett described the new method of calculating passing SOL scores for elementary and middle school as a "growth score" instead of the traditional pass/fail system.

Dr. Bassett explained to the School Board that the new SOL pass rate is "a combined rate that captures students meeting state standards, but even if a student should fail but they show significant progress toward meeting state standards, the combined rate now allows us to receive credit, if you will, for those students who are making significant progress."

She clarified that "even if a student who may have failed a test in reading and math the previous year, but if they participate in a remediation program and pass, then it actually counts twice. If they fail, then it doesn't count at all."

This unconventional approach to testing is the result of a recent bill introduced in the Virginia Legislature by Senator Siobhan Dunnivant

(R) that essentially does away with the traditional SOL test and replaces it with a "growth assessment system" for grades 3 through 8. Full implementation is required by the beginning of the 2022-2023 school year.

While some educators consider this new grading system necessary especially for students affected by post-pandemic learning loss, others find the lenient approach to passing scores part of a larger problem affecting the quality of education in Virginia.

In May 2022, The Youngkin administration released a report on the state of education in the Commonwealth titled, "Our Commitment to Virginians High Expectations and Excellence for All Students."

The report aimed to give an honest look at education in Virginia, and the findings revealed troubling trends. Most notably, the significant decline of Virginia's educational standards and overall SOL Test scores. The

report noted that only 61% of Virginia's 3rd graders demonstrated proficiency on SOL reading tests in 2021, compared with 71% before the pandemic. It found similar declines in grades 4-8.

The report also exposed what it called an "Honesty Gap," or a significant disparity between Virginia SOL pass rates and those of the NAEP or National Assessment of Educational Progress test, also called "The Nation's Report Card." According to 2019 NAEP results, only 38% of Virginia 4th grade students were proficient or advanced in reading, while the SOL data indicated 75% of students were proficient or advanced.

Youngkin explained that the main cause of this Honesty Gap was an intentional lowering of academic standards by the Virginia State Board of Education beginning in 2017 to "mask" or hide failing schools. The report also found that Virginia has the lowest proficiency standards in the nation.

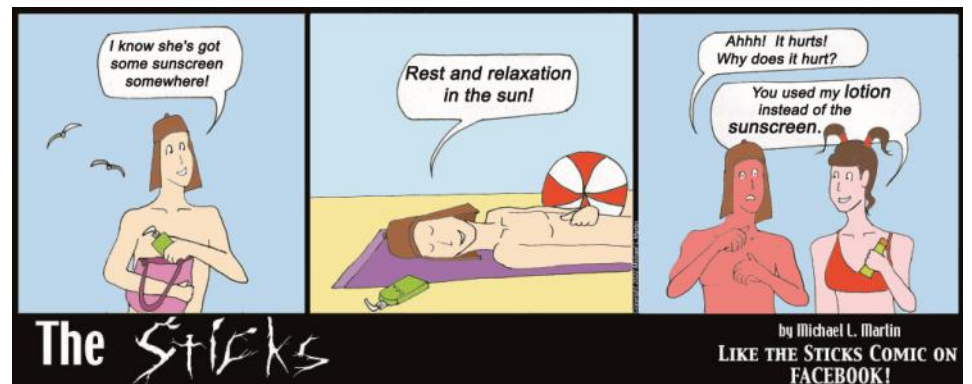

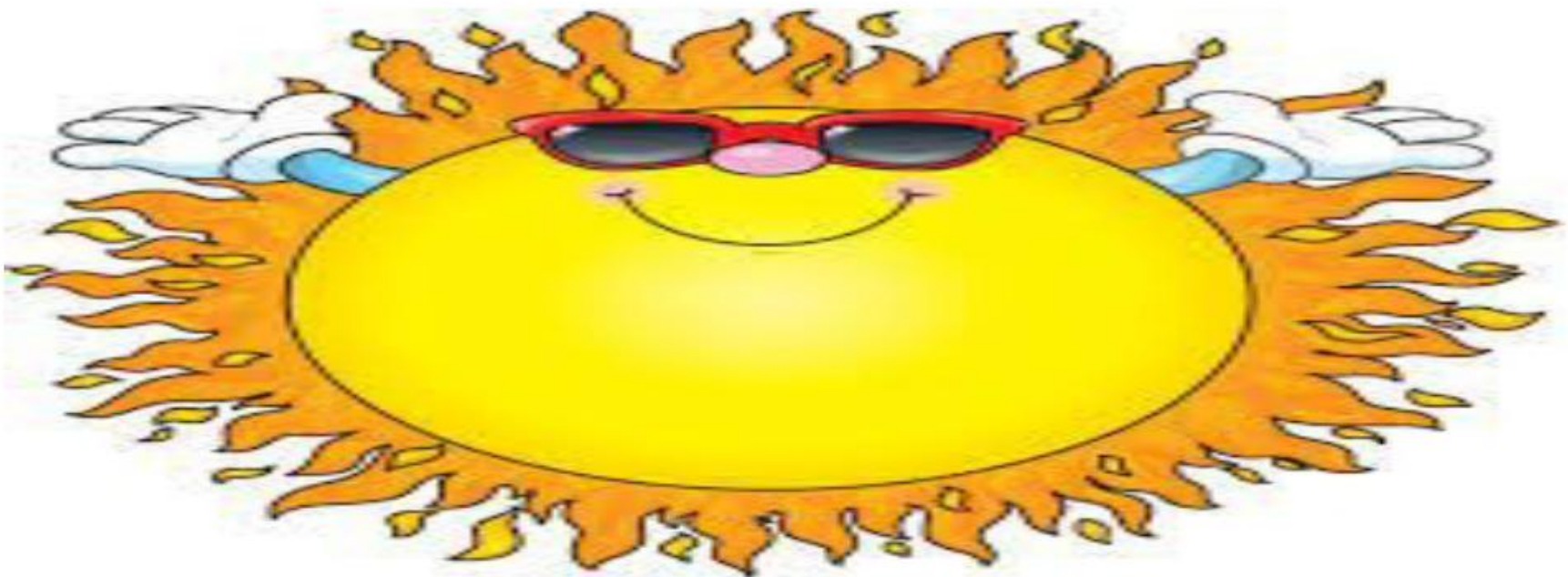
