### The CornerStone Community Development Center Plans Expansion



The food program of 'The CornerStone Community Development Center', Aylett has seen an increasing number of families at the distribution sites since the beginning of the COVID pandemic. That coupled with the current rising costs of groceries because of inflation has made it apparent that an expansion of storage space is necessary to accommodate the increase in demand for food donations.

Since 2001, the food program has occupied the 625 sq. ft, old Aylett post office building which is at the intersection of West River Road and the Richmond Tappahannock Highway and has relied on additional 24x30 storage shed to help with the volume of food that is distributed. No less than 30,000 pounds of food is stored and distributed every month. Now it is evident that the storage space is not adequate to keep up with the demand.

The Board of 'The CornerStone Community Development Center' has proposed a 50x40 metal building to answer the need for more storage space.


### Publisher's Message
