
As residents of King William and King & Queen counties made their way to the polls on November 7th, they were blessed with sunny skies and pleasant weather. All board of supervisors, school boards and constitutional officers were up for election in each county as well as their House of Delegates and Senate representatives in the Virginia General Assembly.

King and Queen County Celebrates Completion of Fiber Broadband







RiverStreet reps present donation to Walkerton Fire Association officials

By Gene Campbell - RiverStreet Networks, a leading provider of broadband services, recently announced the completion of their fiber-to-the-home (FTTH) network in King & Queen County. A celebration marking this significant achievement took place at the King & Queen Library in St. Stephens Church on November 9th. In 2019 King & Queen County and RiverStreet Networks collaborated to build an advanced fiber broadband network to all residential and business customers in the county. RiverStreet built a state-of-the-art infrastructure system ensuring a high-performance internet service for all users. King & Queen County is the first county in Virginia to undergo a comprehensive fiber build and guarantees that every resident in the county will now have access to fiber internet. The project covers 575 miles of fiber connecting 4,236 locations costing approximately \$22 million. Funding for the project included \$14.6 million from grants, \$3.8 million from the county, \$5.8 million from the Virginia Dept. of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) and Virginia Telecommunication Initiative (VATI), and \$5 million from the Federal Communication Commission Connect America Fund (FCC CAF).
