By Gene Campbell- In 1870 Mrs. Susan Davis dreamed of a Baptist Church in West Point. She persuaded the Rev Alfred Bagby then pastor of Mattaponi Church and Exoll Church to come to West Point and hold services on the fifth Sundays. Three years later on December 21<sup>st</sup>, 1873, thirteen persons who were members of Baptist Churches elsewhere and three Baptist ministers met to organize a Baptist Church in West Point. It was from these humble beginnings, that First Baptist Church was formed. On January 21st I had the honor of attending the 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Commemorative Service of First Baptist Church in West Point. It was a joyous occasion.
