## World Champion Wake Surfer on the Mattaponi

Wake surfing is becoming a popular water sport. The rider will get pulled up on a surfboard directly behind the boat. Once underway, the rider can drop the rope and ride the boat's wake. If you frequent the Mattaponi river you've probably seen someone doing this sport.

During the first week in June, pro wake surfer Keenan Flegel flew in from Florida to give lessons on the Mattaponi River. Claire and Carter Bundy won the lessons in a contest from Centurion and Supreme Boats. They had private lessons on the first day and then a few of their friends had lessons on day two. Keenan helped them with their basic form and gave tips on how to learn new tricks. Claire is working on her 360 and getting bigger air off the wake. Carter is trying to land the 180 shuvit more consistently. In addition to riding tips, Keenan explained how to adjust the boat's wake for each rider's style and skill level. By the end of the sessions everyone improved. Even Keenan landed a few tricks he's never done before.

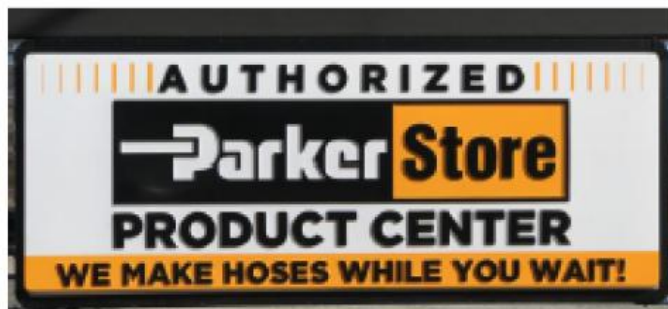

## Broadband Still on Schedule for Completion in August

All Points Broadband Senior Vice President, Tom Innes, gave an update on their broadband progress in the county to the King William Board of Supervisors during its June 10<sup>th</sup> meeting. He stated his company is still on track to substantially complete the installation of high-speed internet to 2,236 homes and businesses in King William County in the third quarter of this year, with a target date of August 5<sup>th</sup>. They are currently installing the last mile (connections to homes) in the lower part of the county (West Point area) moving towards the upper end of the county. The 17.7-million-dollar project has been underway since 2020 incurring several delays along the way. In other matters, the board voted unanimously to repeal Code Section 48-82 of King William's hunting ordinance, allowing the use of rifles for hunting under state guidelines. Five citizens spoke at the public hearing on the matter, all in favor of the repeal.

In new business, Information Technology Director Travis Wolfe gave an update on the renovations to the Dispatch Center and presented proposed new policies and procedures for the county's Information and Technology Department. The board deferred action on the proposed policy changes till its July 8<sup>th</sup> meeting. County Attorney Kelley Kemp led a discussion on the possible repeal of Ordinance 03-23 establishing staggered terms for the election of the Board of Supervisors and School Board. There will be a public hearing on the matter at the July 8<sup>th</sup> board

meeting. Kemp also updated the board on new state law changes that take effect July 1<sup>st</sup> affecting local governments.

During the public comment period, Don and Jeanette Wagner spoke about their concerns about the proposed B2 rezoning of certain land parcels along the Rt 360 corridor and the current ongoing VDOT study reducing speed limits along Rt 360 through the Central Garage area. Audrey Mitchell, President of the Mattaponi and Pamunkey Rivers Assoc, expressed her concern to the board about Caroline County's plans to discharge treated sewage in Pole Cat Creek, a tributary of the Mattaponi River. Lisa Roberts, representing the local NAACP chapter invited the board and citizens to their Second Annual Juneteenth Celebration on the courthouse grounds Saturday, June 15<sup>th</sup> from 10 am – 3 pm.

After returning from a closed session, the board announced the following appointments/reappointments: Evelyn Martin to the Recreation Commission, Greg Henrich to the Planning Commission, Sharon Landrum to the Pamunkey Regional Library Board of Trustees, David Brown and Katie Gibson to the Historic Preservation & Architectural Review Board, Kathy Holiday and Jennifer Boyles to the Economic Development Authority, and approved a recommendation to the Circuit Court for Andrew Scott Duffer to be appointed to the Board of Zoning Appeals. The next meeting of the Board of Supervisors is scheduled for June 17<sup>th</sup> at the administrative complex beginning at 6:30 pm.

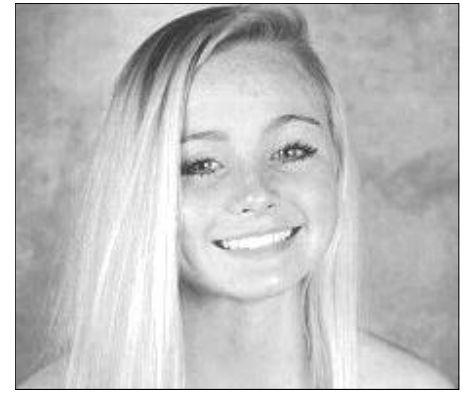

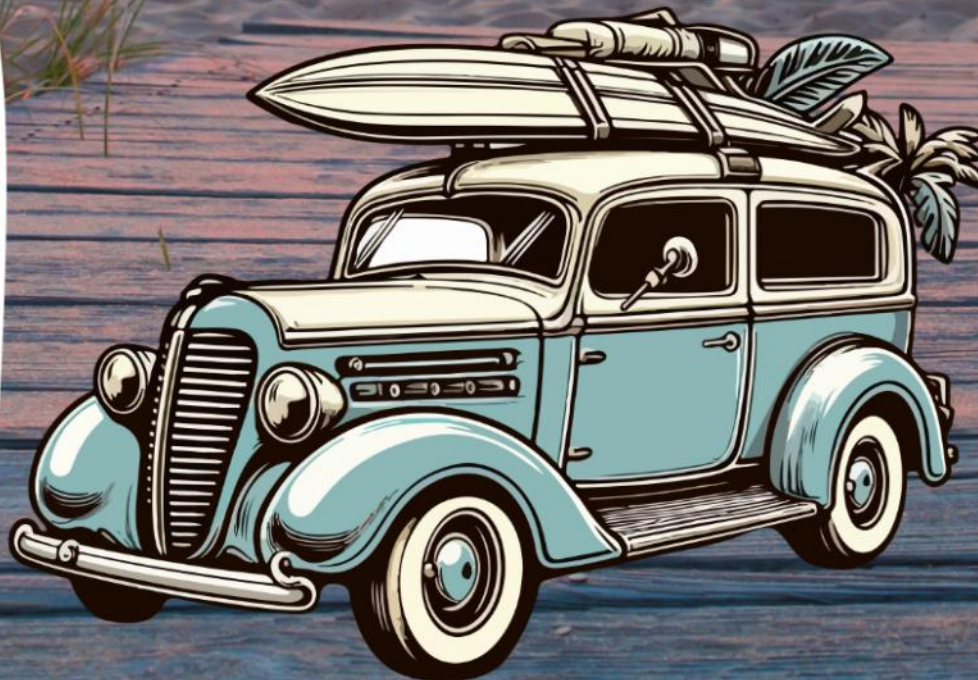

Guest speakers at the King William Democrats' recent meeting were Tyla Matteson and Glen Besa of the York River Group of the Virginia Sierra Club.

Tyla Matteson spoke about the danger of "forever chemicals" known as PFAS, which are common in many everyday products, but are now being found in our water, land, and in our bodies. She reported that high levels of PFAS have been found in our own Mattaponi

River. She stressed that advocacy at the local and state level is urgent to protect future generations from these chemicals.

Glen Besa emphasized that preparing for the effects of Climate Change is also important on the local and state level. He reported that the Infrastructure Act has Federal money available to localities and states to help communities prepare for high water, flooding, and extreme storms. Besa encouraged the KW Democrats to advocate for the continuation of the Virginia Clean Economy Act that sets targets for more solar and wind power, and a reduction in polluting coal power plants.
