



World Champion Wake Surfer on the Mattaponi







8 Time World Wake Surfing Champion Keenan Flegel on the Mattaponi River

Wake surfing is becoming a popular water sport. The rider will get pulled up on a surfboard directly behind the boat. Once underway, the rider can drop the rope and ride the boat's wake. If you frequent the Mattaponi river you've probably seen someone doing this sport.

During the first week in June, pro wake surfer Keenan Flegel flew in from Florida to give lessons on the Mattaponi River. Claire and Carter Bundy won the lessons in a contest from Centurion and Supreme Boats. They had private lessons on the first day and then a few of their friends had lessons on day two. Keenan helped them with their basic form and gave tips on how to learn new tricks. Claire is working on her 360 and getting bigger air off the wake. Carter is trying to land the 180 shuvit more consistently. In addition to riding tips, Keenan explained how to adjust the boat's wake for each rider's style and skill level. By the end of the sessions everyone improved. Even Keenan landed a few tricks he's never done before.
