Broadband, Development, and **Libraries Highlight KWBOS** Meeting

What began in 2017 as a group of concerned citizens calling themselves the King William Internet Connectivity Committee, advocating for broadband services for King William County, is now on the verge of realizing its goals. At the February 24th meeting of the King William County Board of Supervisors, Tom Innes, Senior Vice President of All Points Broadband, announced they have activated their sixth and final cabinet in their 250-mile county network. They have signed up over 400 locations, with some already online, as part of their plan to provide Internet services to 2,500 locations in the county.

In other matters, supervisors unanimously denied a request to rezone 3.86 acres of an 8.97-acre parcel from A-C (Agricultural-Conversation) to B-1 (Local Business) for a proposed Dollar General Market Store to be located at the intersection of Rt 30 and Dabney's Mill Road. According to the applicant, Rhetson Companies, Inc., the store would offer the convenience of a Dollar General, along with fresh meat, produce, and dairy products akin to neighborhood grocer.

King William Courthouse

As we approach the 300th anniversary of our beloved King William County Courthouse, I wanted to share an intriguing piece of history about how close the courthouse came to being relocated to Aylett. When King William County was formed in 1702, a framed dwelling or log home stood on the two-acre parcel of land donated by Henry Fox and Richard Littlepage.
